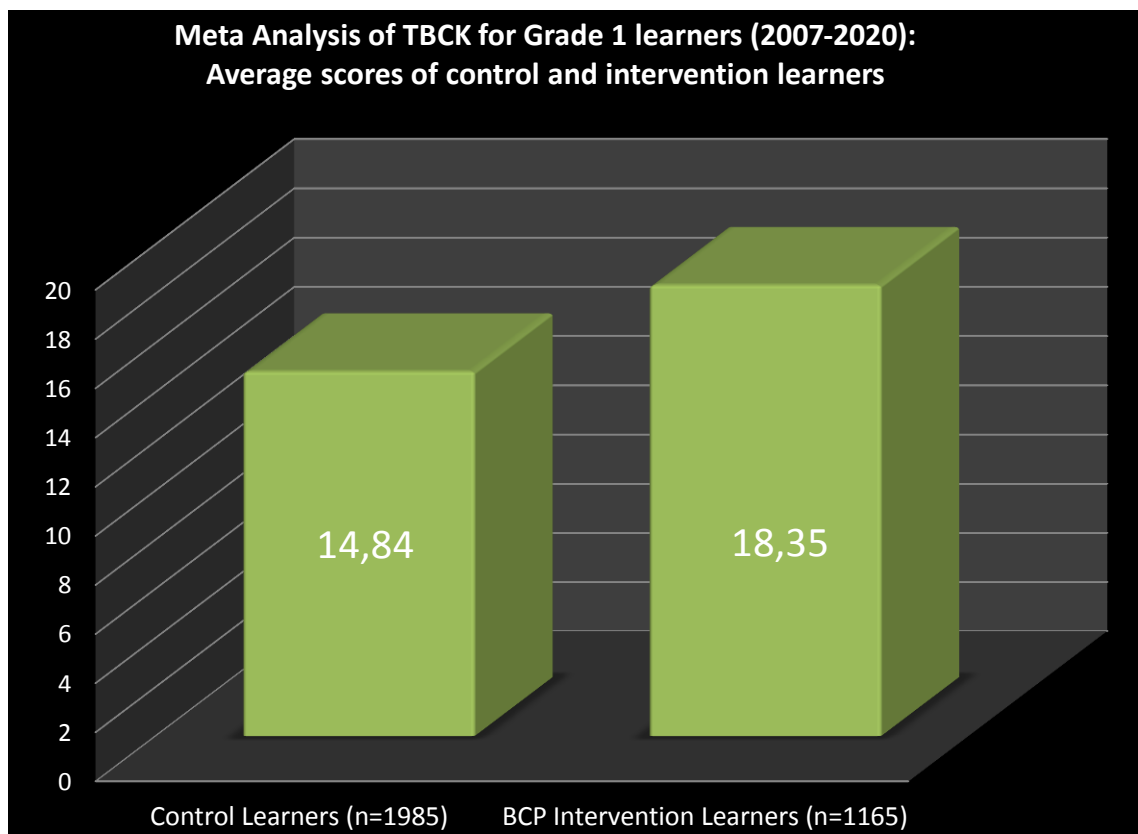


Basic Concepts Programme (BCP)

Test of Basic Concepts Knowledge (TBCK) Results: Meta-Analysis

The data below is based on 3150 learners who were tested using the Test of Basic Concepts Knowledge (TBCK) in 14 projects over the past 14 years.



KEY TO INTERPRET TBCK SCORES:

0-10: Very Weak | 11-17: Weak | 18-24: Average to Strong

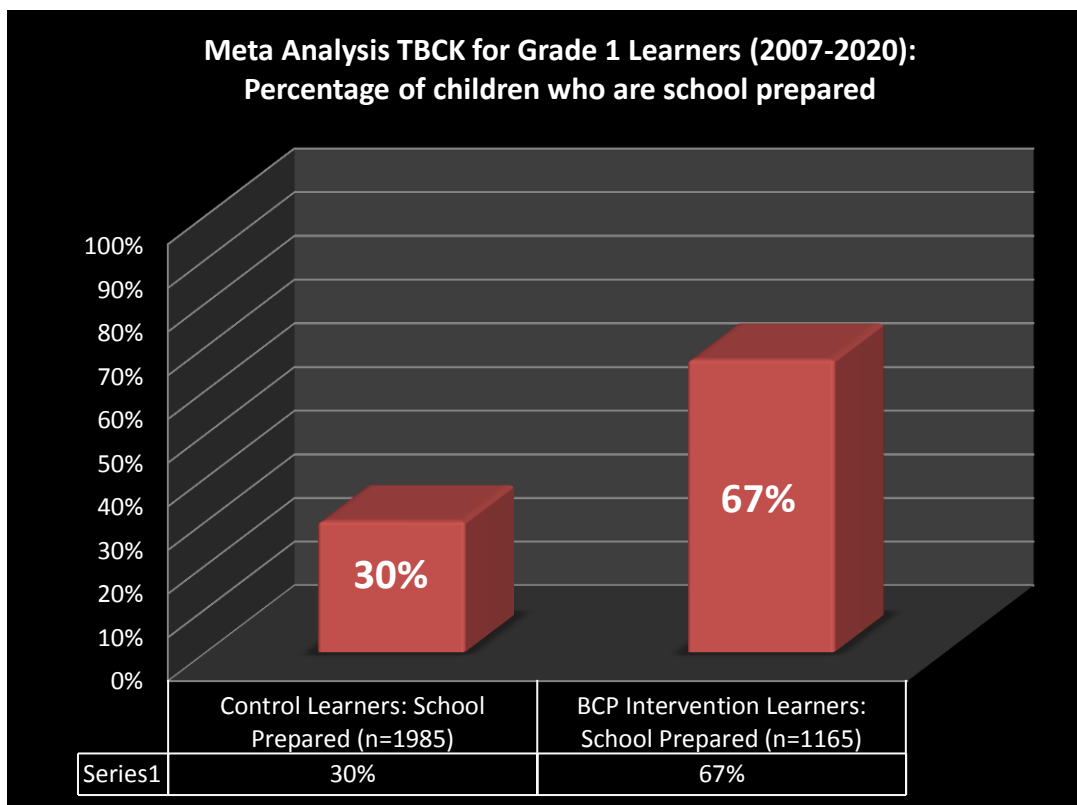
Learners who participated in the BCP in Grade R were on average *found to be school ready* (18,35), while learners who did not participate in the programme in the control group were on average *found not to be school ready* (14,84).

Test of Basic Concepts Knowledge (TBCK) Results: Meta-Analysis

The actual number (expressed as a percentage) of learners found to be school prepared for school learning in the control and BCP intervention group.



67% of the learners who participated in the BCP in Grade R were found to be school prepared as opposed to **30%** of learners who were not exposed to the programme. These results indicate that learners who were exposed to the BCP were **more than twice as likely** to be school prepared than those who were not exposed to the programme.
